Adult Education composing some academic study at university entrance level with the choice of subjects relevant to vocational field PLUS advanced trades skills level course/ training at Government/ Private/ Community/ Non Government Organizations

MVTC Level 3 Certificate which is equivalent to Skills Level 3- Fully Qualified Tradespersons (Equivalent Year 11 Standard)

Tertiary Preparation Course for adult learners (Equivalent Year 12 Standard)

Entry to relevant Government & Non Government Tertiary/ Technical/Business/ Vocational Colleges to pursue Diploma

Skills- Para professional Level 3- Para-professional/ Technician

Entry to various degree programs at Government/ Private Universities and colleges

Professional-Skills Level 2 then proceeds to Skills Level 1 Managers

Work entry pathway

Youth and adult employees in several businesses such as café/restaurant/construction sites/sewing etc

Minimum 4 years experience at employment & relevant onsite assessment/additional training/ application process

MVTC Level 1 Certificate which is equivalent to Skills Level 5-Experienced Elementary Workers

Theory & practical training related to their jobs. For example, cooking skills for restaurant workers/ trade skills for construction site labourers etc + Formal recognition

MVTC Level 2 Certificate which is equivalent to Skills Level 4 –Trained Assistant Tradespersons
